

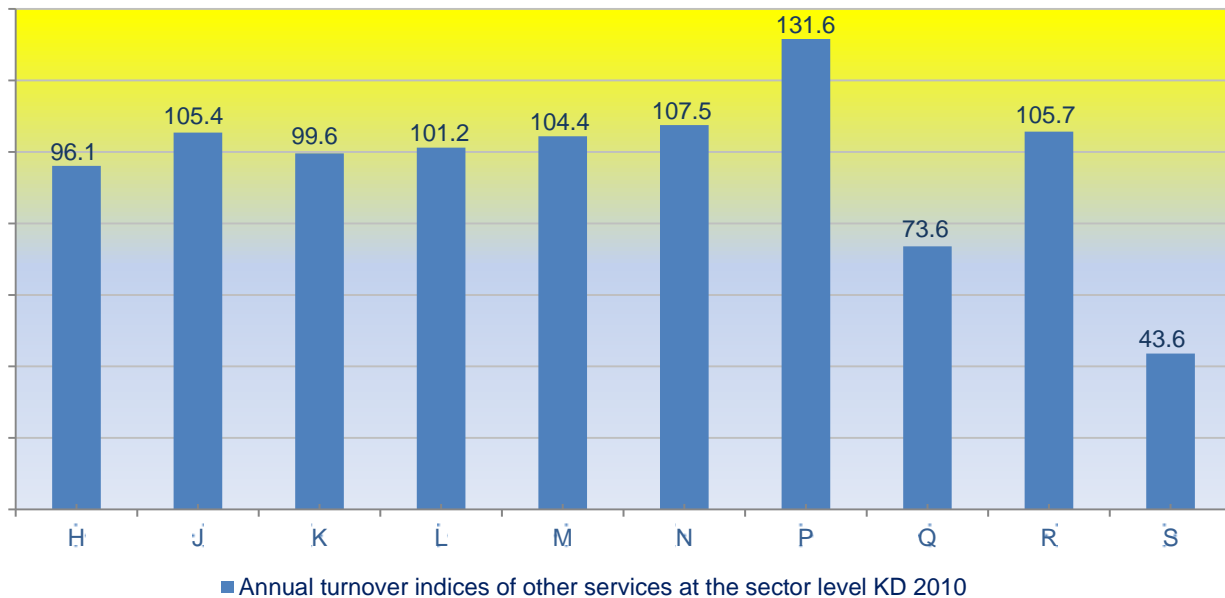
Other Services II quarter of 2012.

Turnover in the area by CA 2010, which includes the concept of other services in the first quarter of 2012, compared to the same period last year in Montenegro increase for 0.5%, observed in current prices.

Turnover in the areas covered by the notion of other services which include the survey in the first quarter was € 274 million.

The largest increase was recorded in the areas of sector P Education service activities by 31.6% while the largest decrease was recorded in the sector S Other services activities is 56.4%

METHODOLOGICAL EXPLANATIONS

Data source and coverage

Data from the area covered by the notion of other services obtained from regular surveys of other services Quarterly report introduced in 2012, while the period of 2010 and 2011, a pilot study was thus given base year 2010.

In conducting quarterly surveys of other services apply stratified sample. Selection units were reporting units in the main activity of H-S sectors. Sample frame was done according to the Statistical Business Register of the Statistical Office of Montenegro-MONSTAT. Sample frame contains 4449 enterprises. For the total population, the sample is selected 510 units (sample size). The survey covers all large businesses (with 50 employees and more), while the small business entities were elected by stratification of the sample. The criteria for inclusion in the sample of business entity was the number of employees. The research is based on the short-term statistics Regulation EU No., 1165/98 (Appendix D).

Definitions

Turnover in the areas covered by the term includes the value of other services performed, provided services to the market in the quarter, regardless of whether they are paid or not. Value added tax, rebates and subsidies were excluded from total turnover. Enterprises reported turnover of services that the core activity and the secondary and ancillary activities performed.

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
