

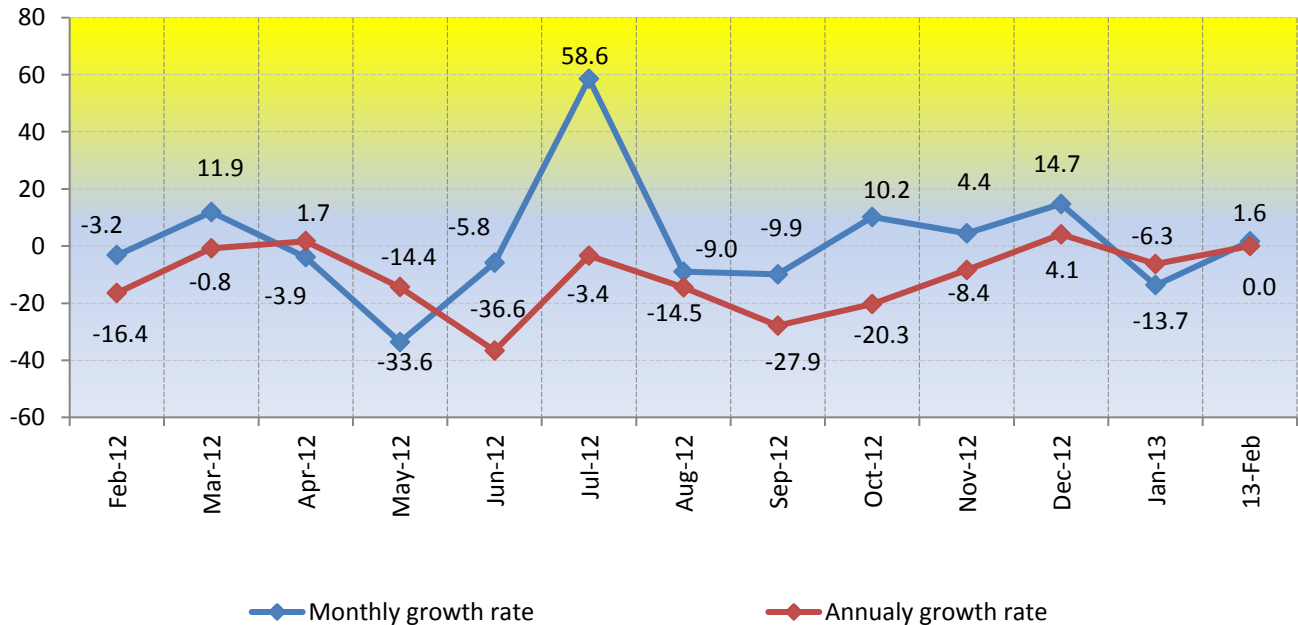
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Industrial turnover indices February 2013

-Pilot survey-

Industrial turnover in Montenegro in February increased 3.7% compared to average monthly turnover from previous year, 1.6 % compared with the previous month , compared to same month of the previous year stay on the same level, while it decrease 3.2 % for period January-February 2013 compared with the same period of previous year.

METHODOLOGICAL EXPLANATIONS

Industrial production indices are one of the most important short-term indicators and a basis for decision making in the area of economy.

Monthly report on industry IND-1 provides the data on industrial production (value of production in reporting month, number of workers, gross earnings of employees, number of hours worked, value of stock, profit from sale - turnover).

Statistical Business Register (SBR) is used as the frame for the coverage for the purposes of this survey. Reporting units are businesses engaged in the industrial production (sectors B,C and D of Activity Classification), as well as parts of commercial businesses classified into other sectors of Activity Classification, and they satisfy the criteria for this survey.

The data are published on the 30th in a month for the previous one, as well as on our website www.monstat.org.

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
