

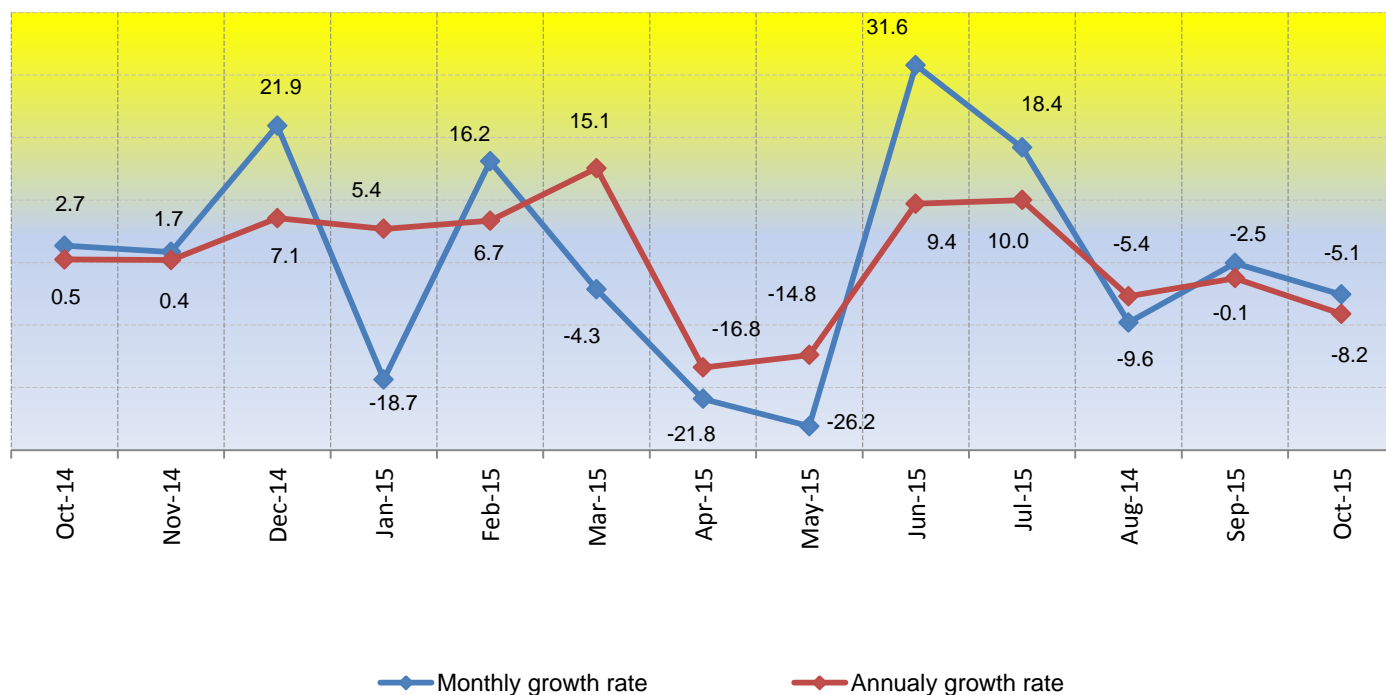

Industrial turnover indices October 2015

Industrial turnover in Montenegro in October increased 0.3% for period January-October 2015 compared with the same period of previous year. Compared with the same month of the previous year, industrial turnover indices decreased 8.2%. Compared to average monthly turnover from previous year it decreased 7.7%. Compared to the previous month it decreased 5.1%.

At the sector level, period January-October 2015 compared to the same period of the previous year, there was an increase in the turnover in sectors: mining and quarrying 12.4%, manufacturing 1.1%, while electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply decreased 3.3% for the observed period.

METHODOLOGICAL EXPLANATIONS

Industrial production indices are one of the most important short-term indicators and a basis for decision making in the area of economy.

Monthly report on industry IND-1 provides the data on industrial production (value of production in reporting month, number of workers, gross earnings of employees, number of hours worked, value of stock, profit from sale - turnover).

Statistical Business Register (SBR) is used as the frame for the coverage for the purposes of this survey. Reporting units are businesses engaged in the industrial production (sectors B, C and D of Activity Classification), as well as parts of commercial businesses classified into other sectors of Activity Classification and they satisfy the criteria for this survey.
