Industrial turnover indices February 2015

Industrial turnover in Montenegro in February increased 17.5 % compared to average monthly turnover from previous year, 16.2% compared to the previous month, 6.7% compared with the same month of the previous year and 6.1 % for period January-February 2015 compared with the same period of previous year.

Graph 1. Growth rates of industrial turnover

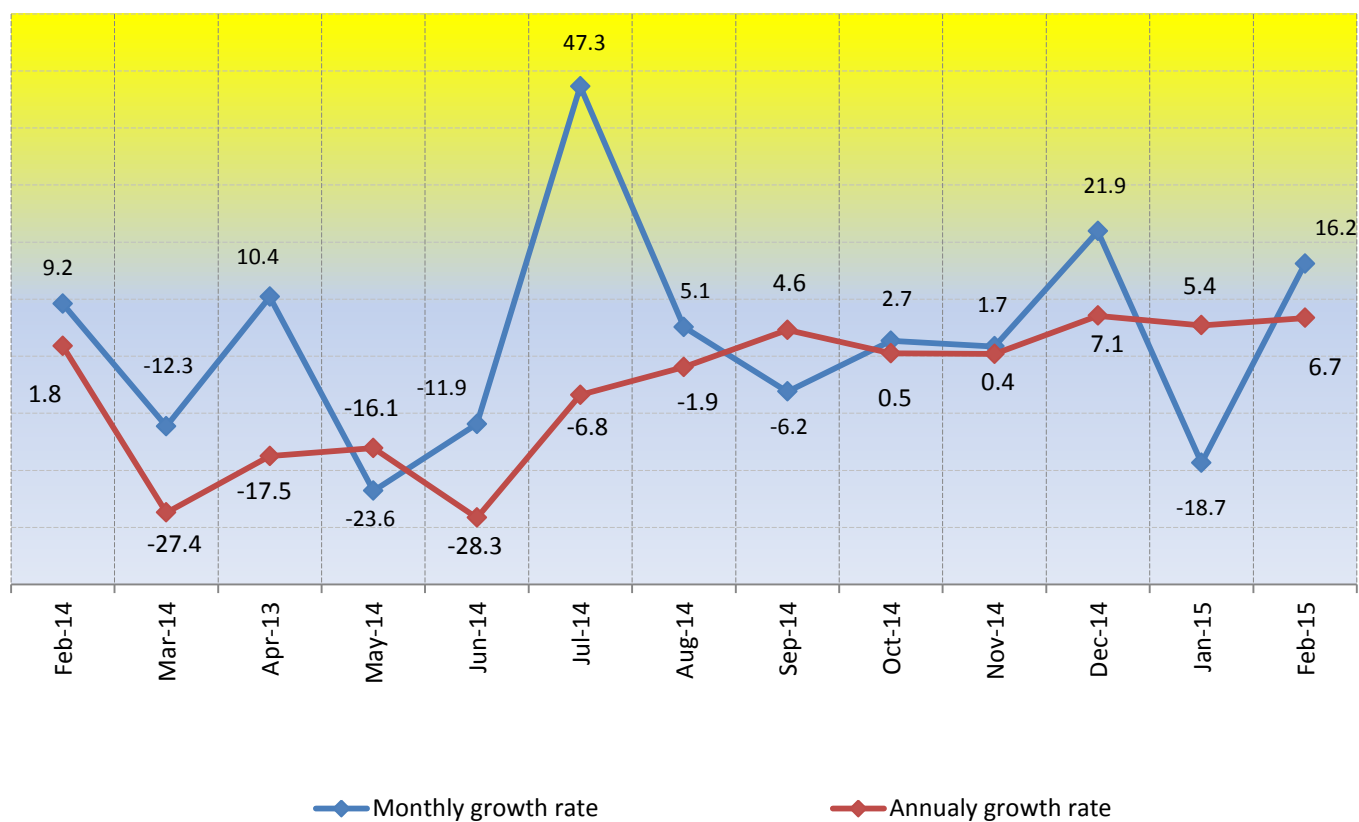

METHODOLOGICAL EXPLANATIONS

Industrial production indices are one of the most important short-term indicators and a basis for decision making in the area of economy.

Monthly report on industry IND-1 provides the data on industrial production (value of production in reporting month, number of workers, gross earnings of employees, number of hours worked, value of stock, profit from sale - turnover).

Statistical Business Register (SBR) is used as the frame for the coverage for the purposes of this survey. Reporting units are businesses engaged in the industrial production (sectors B, C and D of Activity Classification), as well as parts of commercial businesses classified into other sectors of Activity Classification and they satisfy the criteria for this survey.
