

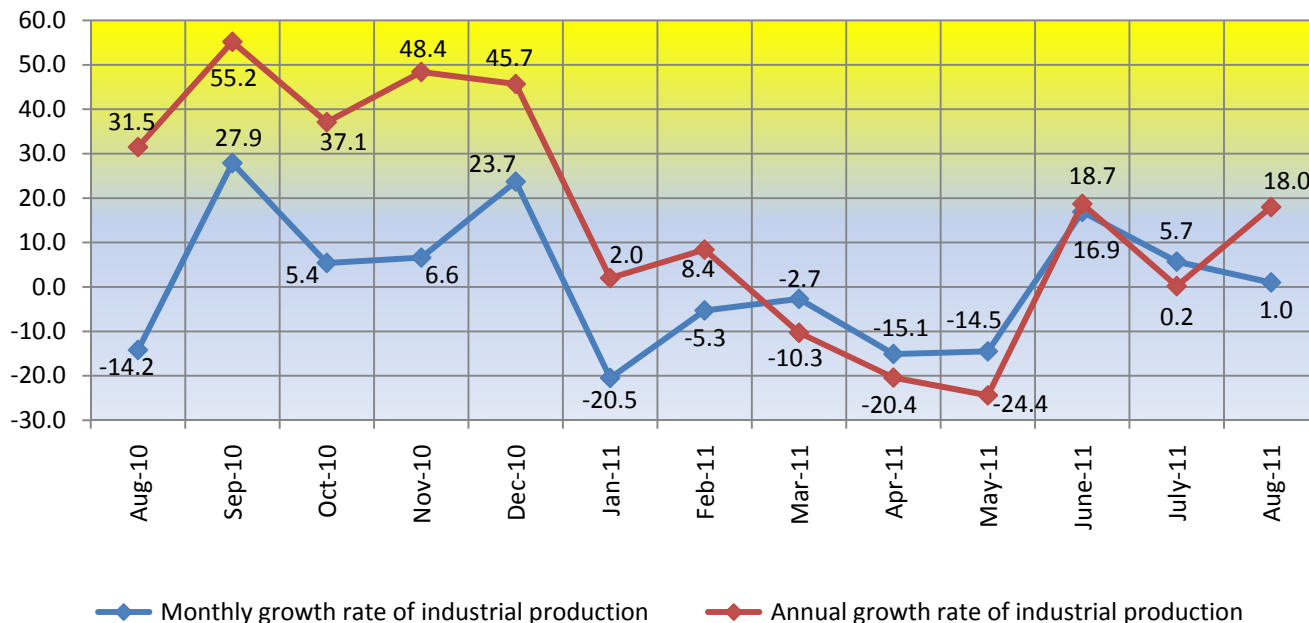

## Indices of industrial production August 2011

Industrial production in Montenegro in August decreased: 6.6% for period January-August 2011 compared to the same period in 2010, 12.0% compared to average monthly production from previous year, while it increased 18.0% compared to same month of the previous year, and it increased 1.0% compared to the previous month.

At the section level, period January-August 2011 compared to the same period of the previous year, there was an increase in the production in two sections: mining and quarrying 2.7%, and manufacturing 12.1%, while electricity, gas, and water supply decreased 28.3 % for the observed period.

## METHODOLOGICAL EXPLANATIONS

Industrial production indices are one of the most important short-term indicators, and a basis for decision making in the area of economy.

Monthly report on industry IND-1 provides the data on industrial production (quantity of products produced in the reporting month, from beginning to the end of reporting month, quantities of final products in stocks, sale of final products from beginning to the end of reporting month, value of production in reporting month, number of workers, gross earnings of employees, number of hours worked, value of stocks, profit from sale - turnover).

Statistical Business Register (SBR) is used as the frame for the coverage for the purposes of this survey. Reporting units are businesses engaged in the industrial production (sections C and D, and E of Activity Classification), as well as parts of commercial businesses classified into other sections of Activity Classification, and they satisfy the criteria for this survey.

The data are published on the 15<sup>th</sup> in a month for the previous one, as well as in our website [www.monstat.org](http://www.monstat.org).
