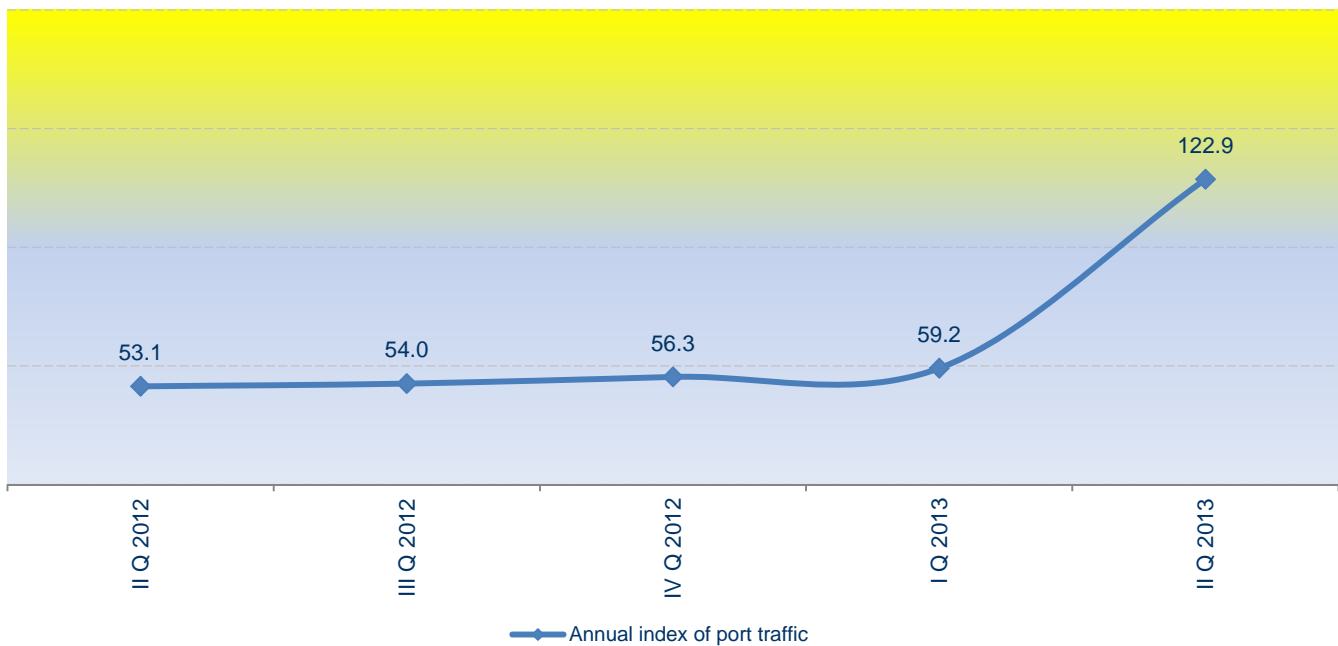


## Report on the arrival and departure of ships in ports The second quarter 2013

## METHODOLOGICAL NOTES

### Source of data

The data on maritime transport are the result of regular quarterly surveys on reporting units with the sea transport of goods and tonne-miles, as well as export and import in port as the main activity.

### Coverage

The surveys cover enterprises classified within the Classification Unit Register by Activity Classification in Section H (Transport and storage), Area 50.

### Definitions

Ports are places for loading/embarkation and unloading/disembarkation passengers and goods at the seashore built particularly for this purpose, while docks are similar places on riverbanks and lakefronts. Total port traffic in addition to the export and import also comprises inland traffic.

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
