

Maritime transport of goods The first quarter 2013

This release presents the data on the carriage of goods in the sea transport.

Amount of transported goods, in tons, by sea in the first quarter 2013 compared with the same quarter of previous year decrease 81.6%.

Graph 1. Annual index of transported goods

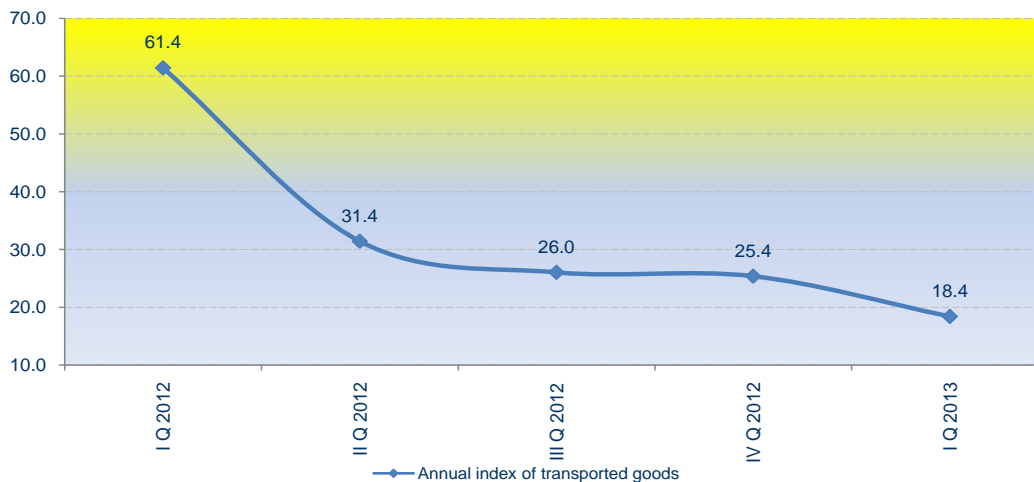

METHODOLOGICAL NOTES

Source of data

The data on maritime transport are the result of regular quarterly surveys on reporting units with the sea transport of goods and tonne-miles.

Coverage

The surveys cover enterprises classified within the Classification Unit Register by Activity Classification in Section H (Transport and storage), Area 50.

Definitions

Ports are places for loading/embarkation and unloading/disembarkation passengers and goods at the seashore built particularly for this purpose, while docks are similar places on riverbanks and lakefronts.
