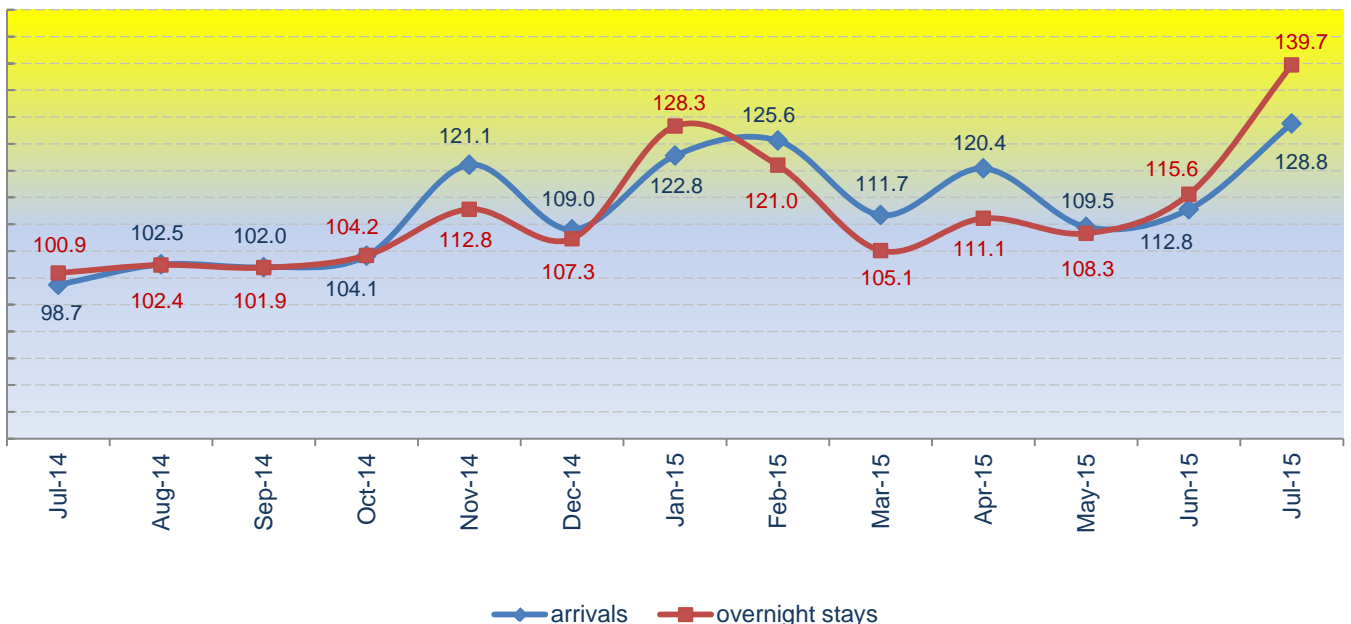
Tourist arrivals and overnight stays July 2015^(p)

In Montenegro, in July 2015 tourists realised 442 461 arrivals which is 28.8% more than in July 2014. The number of realised overnight stays is 3 227 083, which is 39.7% more than in July 2014. Overnight stays of foreign tourists represent 95.6% while the domestic tourists represent 4.4% of all overnight stays in July 2015.

Concerning the structure of overnight stays of foreign tourists, in July 2015, the most of them were realised by tourists from Serbia (35.6%), Russia (25.7%), Bosnia and Herzegovina (10.4%), Ukraine (3.9%), Poland (2.3%), Germany (2.0%), Kosovo (1.8%), Macedonia (1.5%). Tourists from other countries realised 16.8% overnight stays.

Concerning the structure of overnight stays by type of resort, the most of them were realised in seaside resorts (98.6%), mountain resorts (0.5%), capital city (0.5%), in other tourist resorts and other resorts.

Graph 2. Structure of tourist arrivals and overnight stays by cities, July 2015

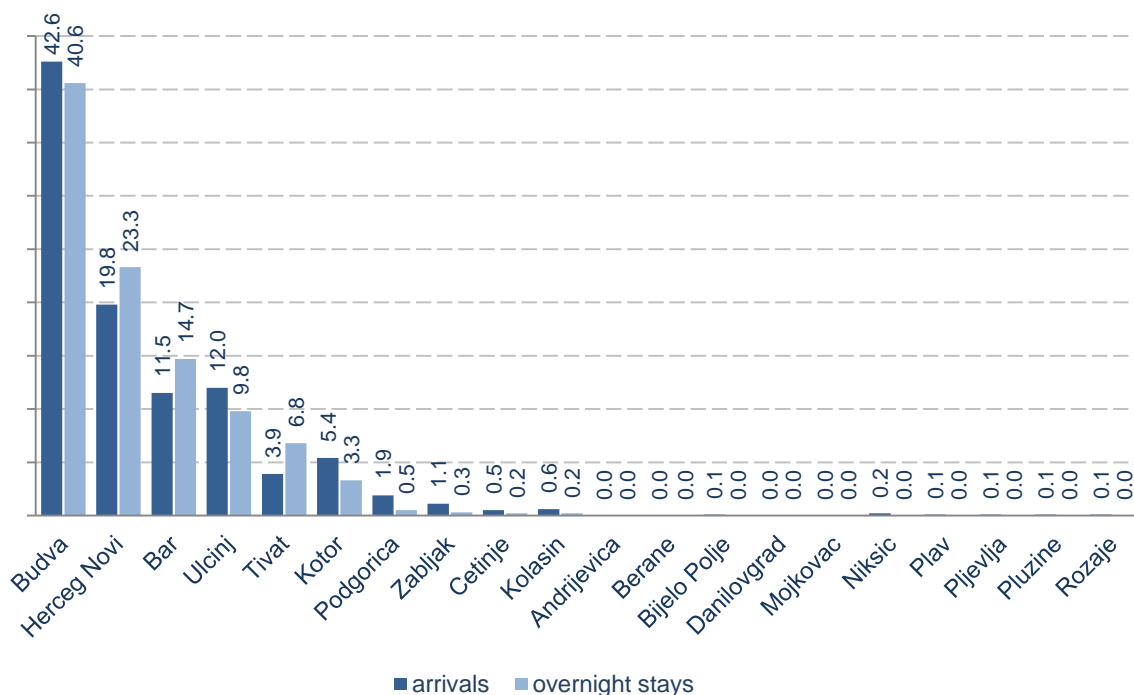

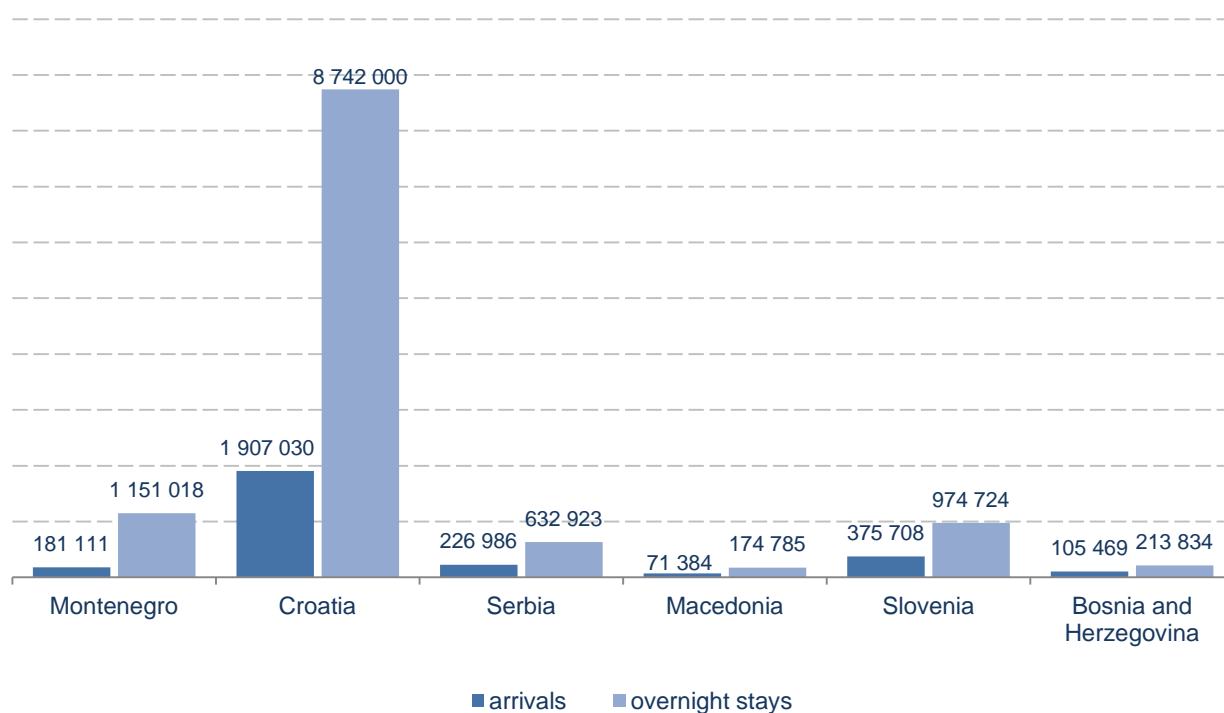

METHODOLOGICAL NOTES

Data on tourist turnover have been collected by regular Monthly report on tourists arrivals and overnight stays in the accommodation establishments (form TU-11). Reports are made on basis of reception records in guest books.

Tourist is a person who spends at least one night in an accommodation facility or some other object for accommodation of tourist, in a place other than his/her place of permanent residence for the reasons of rest or recreation, health, studies, sports, religion, family, business, public missions or meetings. Tourists do not include migrants, border workers, diplomats, member of military forces in the regular duty, refugees. etc.

Domestic tourist is a person with permanent residence in Montenegro who temporarily resides in any place of Montenegro, and spends at least one night in accommodation facility.

Foreign tourist is a person with permanent residence outside Montenegro, who temporarily resides in any place in Montenegro, and spends at least one night in an accommodation facility.
