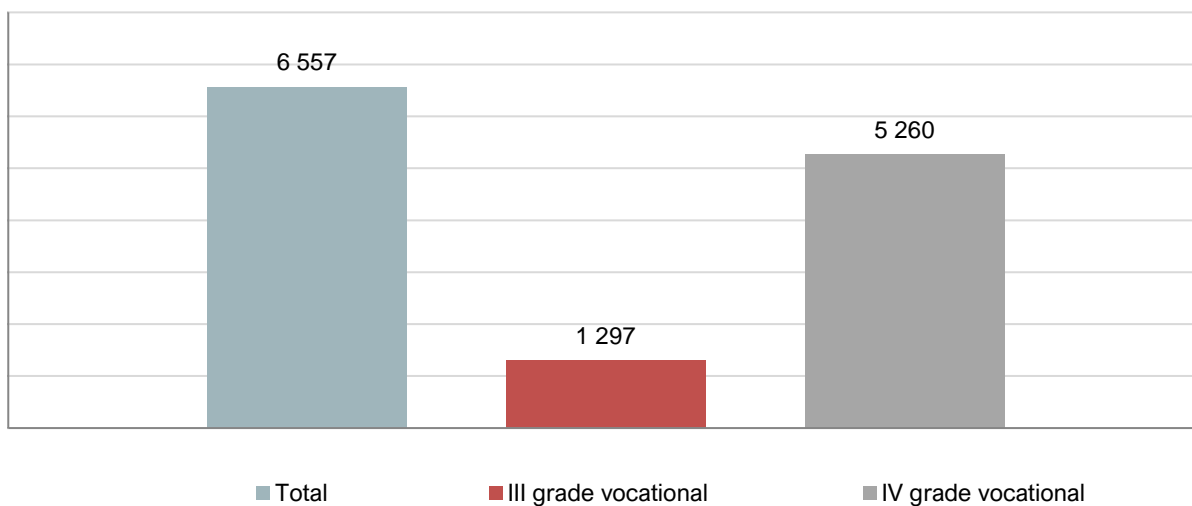
- *Secondary schools* -

At the end of school year 2021/2022

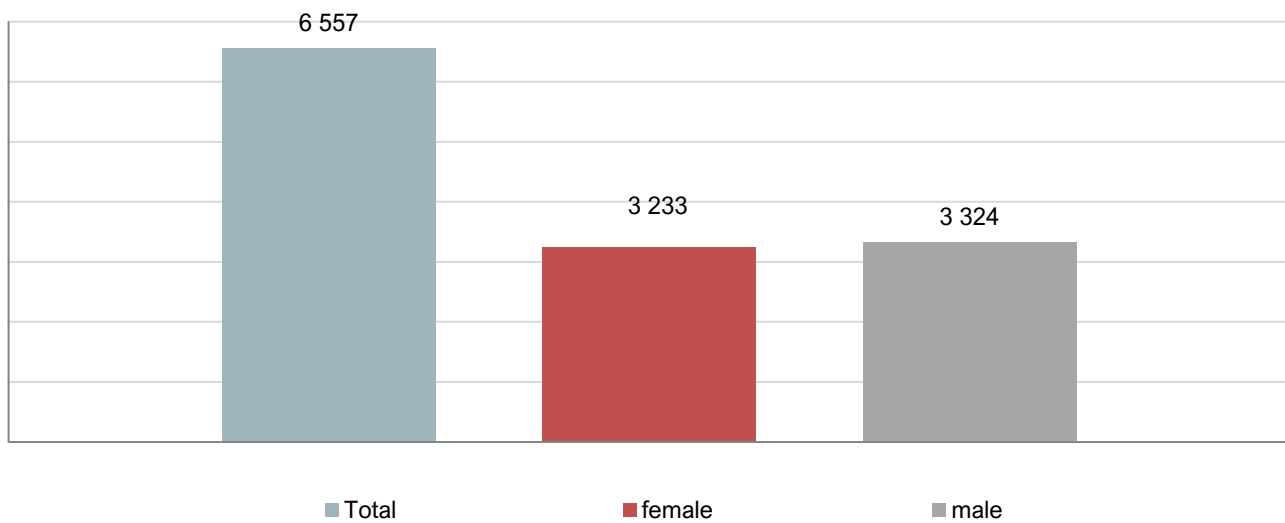
Data in release are related to the number of pupils who completed regularly secondary education in Montenegro in secondary schools at the end of school year 2021/2022.

The number of pupils who completed regularly secondary education in secondary schools in school year 2021/2022 is 6 557, III grade of vocation 1 297 and IV vocational grade 5 260 pupils.

Graph 1. Pupils who completed regularly secondary education III and IV vocational grade at the end of school year 2021/2022

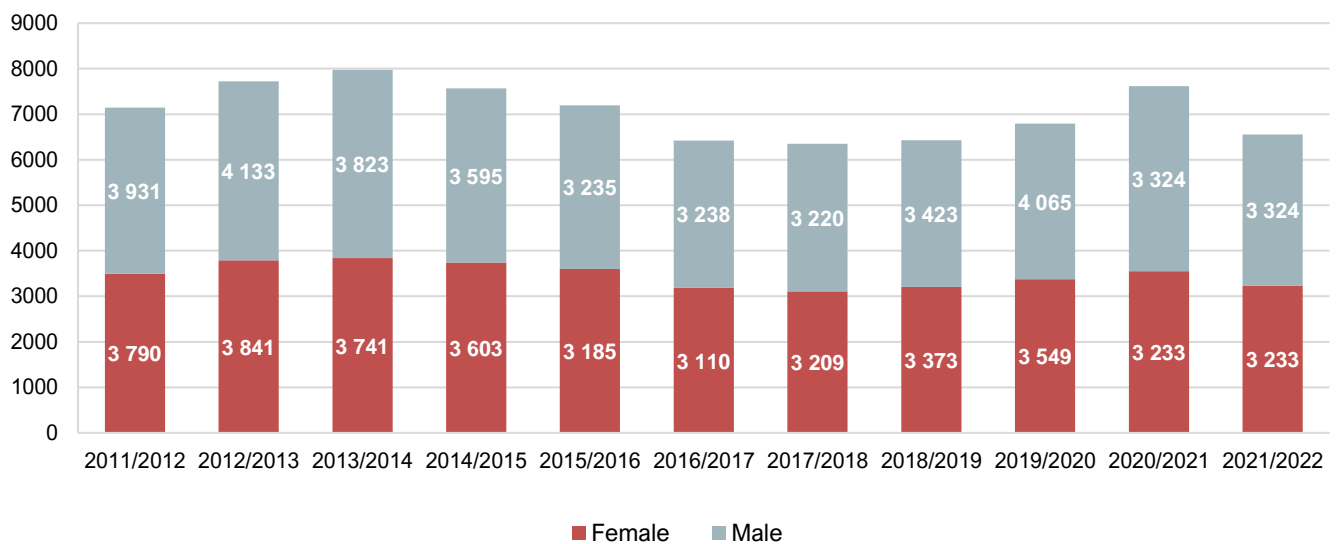


Graph 2. Pupils who completed regularly secondary education in secondary schools

- Of the total number of pupils who completed regularly secondary school (6 557), 49.3% or 3 233 are female and 50.7% or 3 324 are male.
- General secondary education – gymnasium completed 1 952 (29.8%), and vocational schools 4 605 (70.2%) pupils.

METHODOLOGICAL NOTES

The data on secondary education in this release refer to the end of school year 2021/2022, and they are results of statistical processing of the Ministry of Education– MEIS).

The statistical survey covered all secondary schools and resource centres that work in accordance with the programme of Ministry of Education.

The school year is the period in which regular classes and other forms of educational work take place. In education statistics, a school is considered a group of pupils organized into one school unit, with several teachers who teach according to the established programme.

Pupils who finished school in secondary education obtained the III and IV level of education according to the International Standard Classification of Education (ISCED 2011) level ISCED 3.
