

## Indices of agricultural production, 2011

Total agricultural production in Montenegro in 2011 compared to the previous year increased by 9.5% because of increasing crop production by 2.7% and 19.9% for livestock.

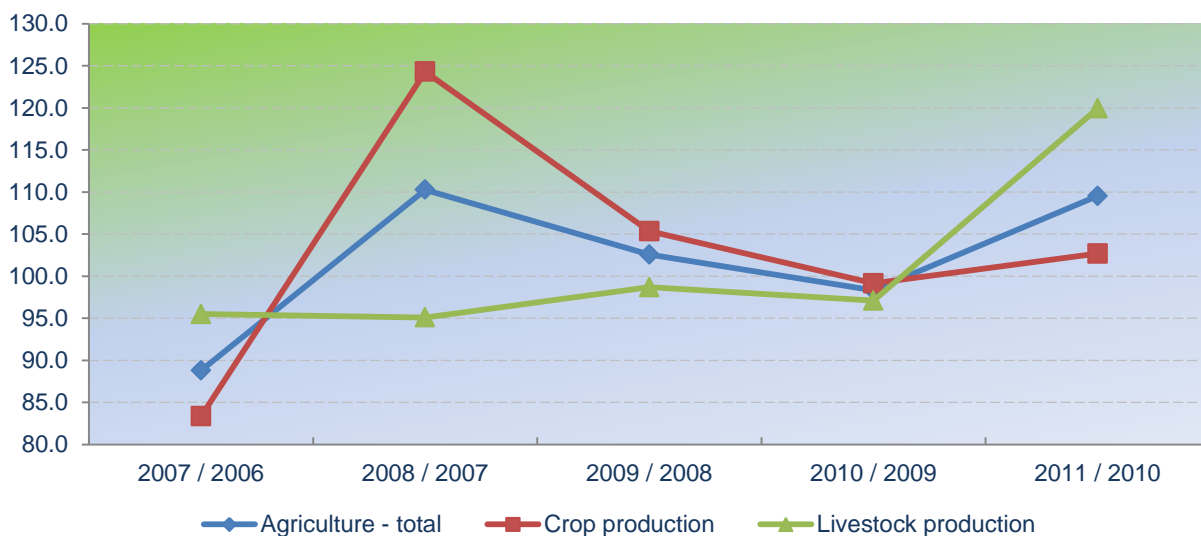
In crop production, there has been a significant increase in the production of potatoes, carrots, maize, oats, fodder maize, plums, apples and pears. In livestock production, production of cow and ewe milk and accrual of sheep and pigs, increased significantly.

From total agricultural production in 2011, share of crop production is 56.6% and 43.4% of livestock production.

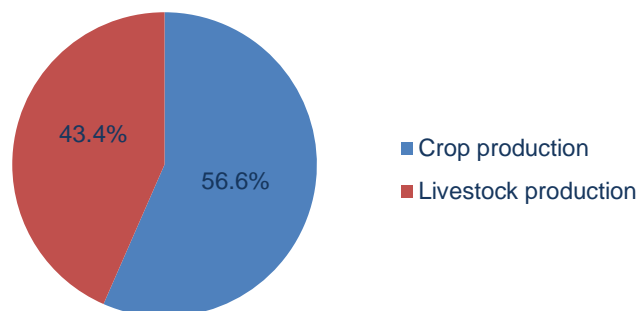

### **METODOLOGICAL NOTES**

The aim of calculating the index of agriculture production is to provide data for regular measurement of changes in the volume of total agricultural production and changes in production volume by of agricultural groups. and subgroups of agricultural products.

Indices of agriculture production are calculated from data obtained by the regular annual surveys about quantities production of crop and animal primary products.

For the calculation of the index of livestock production used the data about accrual of livestock and poultry by species (cattle, sheep and pigs) and primary animal product (cow and ewe milk, wool, eggs, honey), and refer to 01/11/2011.

For the calculation of the index of crop production, the data on the yields of early, late crops, fruits, grapes and olives.

To calculate the index of total agricultural production, we used data on crop and livestock production.
