

Annual survey on railway network 2013

Really length of railways in Montenegro in the 2013 amounted to 248.76 km and is the same in relation to the 2012.

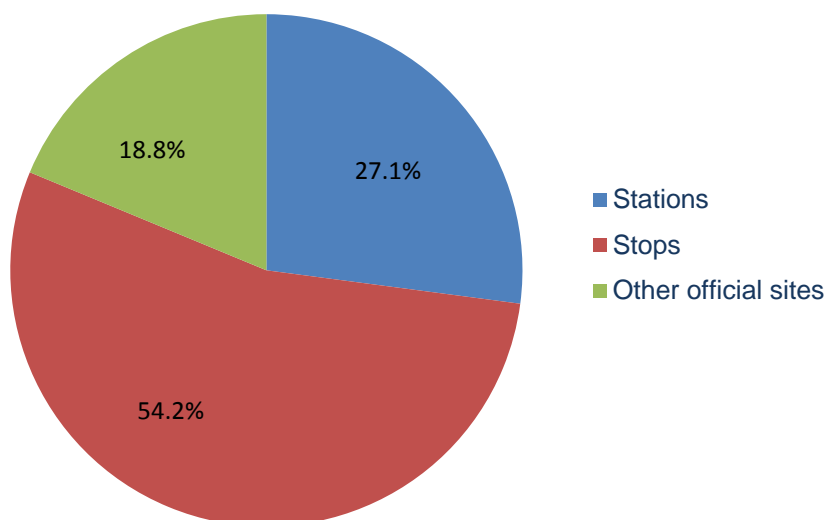
Number of stations and other official sites is 48, from which stop constitute 54.2%, stations 27.1%, while other official sites make up 18.8%.

METHODOLOGICAL NOTES

Data source

The data on railway network are the result of regular annual surveys on reporting units, which is the maintenance of the railway infrastructure core business.

Definitions

The railway is intended solely for movement of train. Data on the length of railway lines are shown as building and as the really length.

Building length is measured from baseline to end point. Building length : open line and length of the main wicket-track in stations and other official places.

The really length of the line is the length of the open line and cellular transient gauge, and is measured from the middle to the middle station buildings or other official sites.
